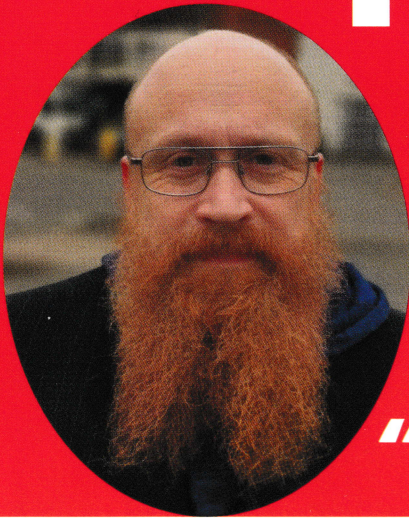

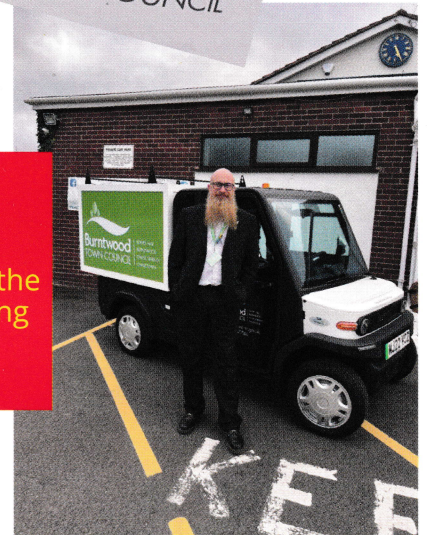
Chasetown Ward's Labour District and Town Councillor, Darren Ennis, said:

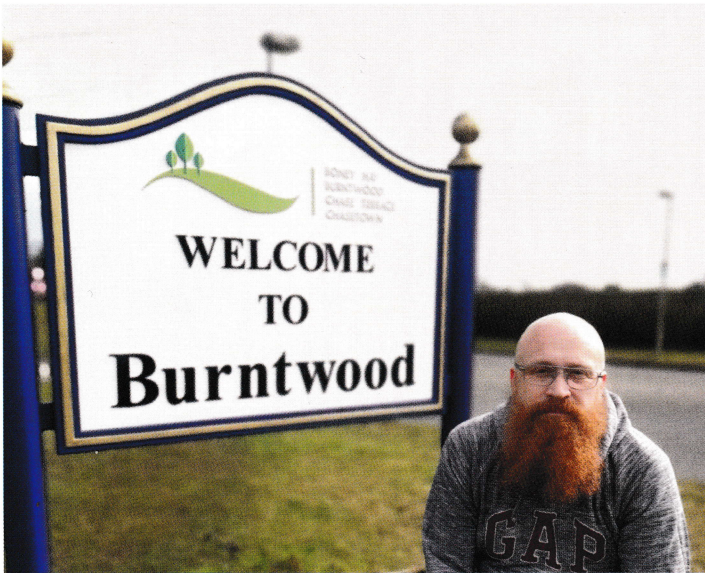
